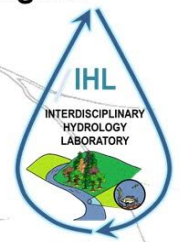

Dr. Jason Hubbart serves as the Associate Dean of Research, Associate Director of the West Virginia Agricultural and Forestry Experiment Station, Director of the WVU Institute of Water Security and Science, and as Professor of Physical Hydrology and Water Quality in the Davis College of Agriculture, Natural Resources and Design. Previously, Dr. Hubbart was a faculty member and center director at the University of Missouri (2007 – 2015). Dr. Hubbart currently serves as the gubernatorial appointee to the Science and Technical Advisory Committee (STAC) of the Chesapeake Bay Program and is a member of the Southern Region Extension and Research Activities Committee (SERA-46) of the Gulf Hypoxia Task Force. He teaches and conducts research and has published over 80 peer reviewed articles in the fields of physical hydrology, watershed management and water quality, and environmental biophysics, and directs the WVU Interdisciplinary Hydrology Laboratory.
